
Value Added Certifications


Overall, the session provided MBA students with valuable insights into the importance of effective business process engineering and its potential impact on achieving sustainable excellence in business operations.




engaged with eight funding agencies to support these endeavors and has been instrumental in enhancing various organizations' capabilities and effectiveness.




Value Added Certifications






