Curricular

Teaching, Learning & Evaluation

The year witnessed a re-transition of teaching from online to hybrid to complete offline mode. The semesters were delayed due to the prevalent pandemic restrictions. Faculties were trained for online students' engagement and use of blended tools. With the relaxations in covid norms offline lectures started from February 2022. Semester 3 was conducted online till January and from February offline lectures were conducted as per schedule. The admissions for new academic year were delayed due to pandemic and the entire process was completed by the end of December. Teaching & Learning for the first semester commenced second week of January. The Institute follows SP University Revised syllabus 2019, as per syllabus Concurrent Internal Evaluation is done based on the Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation suggested by the syllabus. The CCE's were conducted online as per the planned schedule and submissions were received online using VmEdulife software. The students appeared for university exams that were conducted online in the month of April. After exams as per university circular the teaching learning for MBA Sem II and Sem IV was initiated.

Induction

The induction aims to familiarize the aspiring managers to the MBA course. The theme for this year's induction was "Euphoria" next level energy. Students from different parts of the country took admission for the MBA program. However, considering the pandemic situation, few students were called for the induction ceremony by following all the covid protocols. The chief guest for induction was Mr. Mohan Nair, Esquire Health Care and Logistics Pvt. Ltd.'He addressed the audience on the topic 'Skill Sets Required in Digital Era and Inner Governance for future Managers'. On the inaugural official Signing of 'Memorandum of Understanding' between 'Auto Cluster', and 'PCSIC' with MBA@IICMR was also done. Total duration of the Induction ceremony was eight days, during which students were familiarized with the culture of MBA@IICMR, discipline, punctuality, course content, teaching-learning schedules, evaluation methods, cocurricular and extra-curricular activities. The induction motivated, encouraged and prepared the students for embracing the two-year MBA journey at MBA@IICMR.

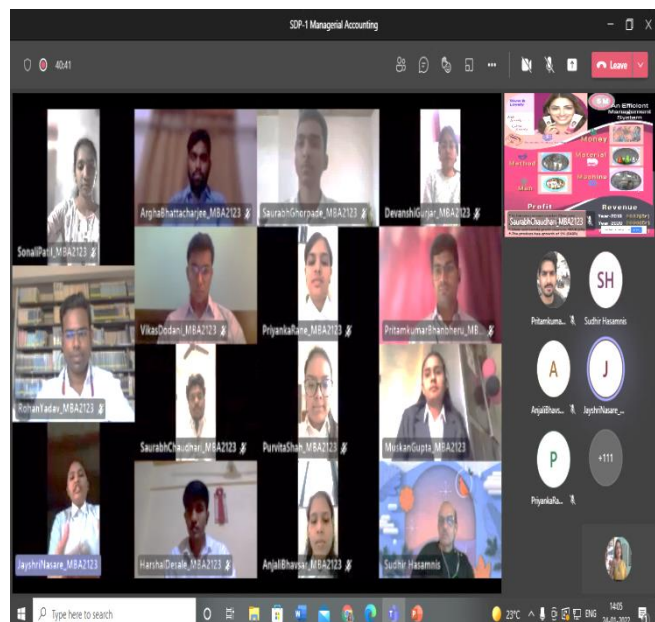

SDP 1: The first SDP for MBA I Semester I was conducted on 24 January 2022. This SDP was aligned to the course GC-101-Managerial Accounting and the theme was "Revenue, Cost and Profitability analysis of a Product" based on the CCE Creating and Presenting Posters. The students were suggested to review the annual reports, (Trading, Profit & Loss A/c and Balance Sheet) of the company, website of the company to support the presentation. Further they were also encouraged to suggest innovative ideas related to optimum utilization of resources, increasing revenue, reduction in cost, minimizing loss, and increasing profit. The winning team was 'The lean Planner' and runner-up were team "High Flyers" This SDP was conducted online on MsTeams and judges for this SDP were Dr. Abhay Kulkarni, Director, IICMR and Dr. Sudhir Hasamnis, Associate Faculty MBA@IICMR. A total of 121 members including faculty and students were present for the first SDP.



The second SDP for MBA I Semester I was conducted on 15th February 2022. This SDP was aligned to the course GC-103- Economic Analysis and Business Decisions and the theme was "Catch Me if You Can" based on the CCE Role Play/Presentation. The judges for this SDP were Mr. Ketan Gandhi and Dr. Jayasri Murali. A total of 83 students attended this SDP. The winner for this SDP was Team Symbiotic, they presented the Hawala scam.



SDP3: The third SDP for MBA I Semester I was conducted on 1st March 2022. This SDP was aligned to the course GC-102- Organizational Behavior and the theme was "Fish Bowl" based on the CCE prescribed by the SPPU syllabus. 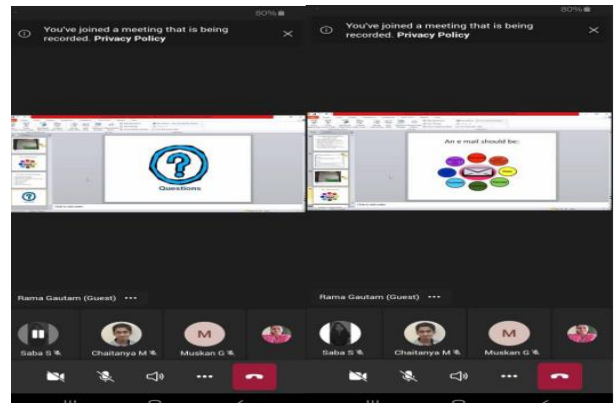
Career Excellence Program

Employability Enhancement Program (EEP)

The Employability enhancement program envisages to make students industry ready. EEP sessions are conducted throughout the third and fourth semester. In pursuit of this endeavor the (EEP) program is designed to provide the students sessions on aptitude training, interview skills, Group discussions, resume writing, self-introductions. The EEP sessions conducted this year were:

The first EEP session was about "Online Impression Management" conducted by Ms. Neha Bhosale. This EEP oriented the students on online interview etiquettes. The trainer emphasized on key points like having a good back ground, preferably sitting in a no noise zone, right dressing sense is very important along with right attitude which includes greeting properly and listening and then conveying the information properly, stable internet connection and placing of the camera.



EEP 2: This EEP session was conducted by Ms. Mousami Nilakhe on the topic "Ace the personal Interview" The session was on guiding the students about the methods of acing the personal interview. She mentioned and explained the elements of interviews, by sharing that the interview consists of 55% of body language, 38% of voice, tone and variation and 7% of actual words.



EEP3: Rubicon Life skill Workshop. A two day workshop was conducted on 14th & 15th March. This workshop intended to groom the students for getting corporate ready. The workshop familiarized students with key concepts pertaining to Organization Structure, SWOT analysis, corporate jargons and public speaking, presentation skills, email etiquettes and phone etiquettes as well as the techniques of group discussions. The workshop was interactive and activity based and students emerged more confident after the workshop



EEP 4- Aptitude Training. The students were provided a series of session for developing the acumen for solving the aptitude tests for getting a job. Seminars

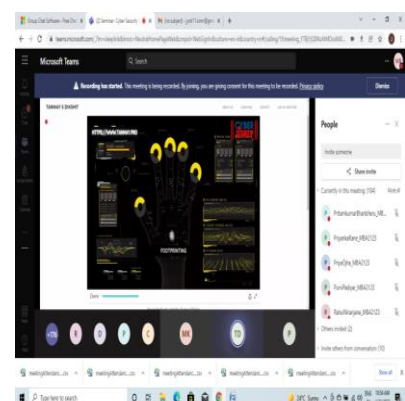

This activity inculcates the habit of reading newspapers. During pandemic this activity was conducted online, where the students were asked to post news online. This was a group activity and mentor-wise student groups were given opportunity to post news on the IICMR Today Whatsapp group for each week, at the end of the week test was conducted to understand the extent to which students remember current affairs. Mentoring

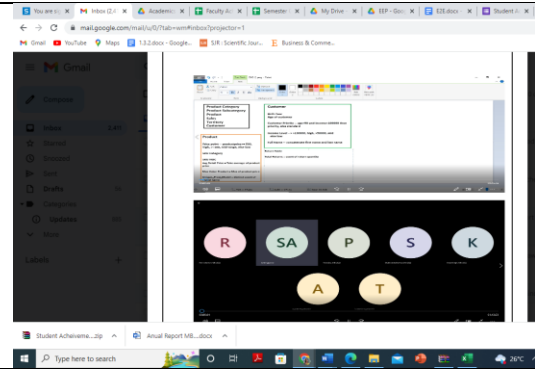
Value Added Certification for Sem III was on Financial Modelling. This certification provided Real Time Investment banking & Equity Research exposure.

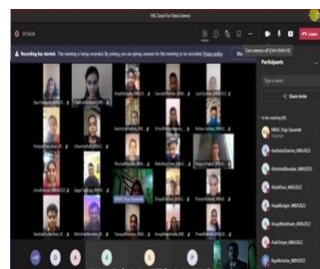


Activities of Placement Cell
