#### 3. Abstract about PoC:

Owing to the modern lifestyle, heavy traffic on road the health issues (emergency medical services) for the human beings are to be responded immediately after mishap. The citizens facing accidental medical casesor any such emergency medical help require immediate attention. Thus to bridge the gap between managing and arranging medical help to patients in emergency, the concept of **Arogya Mitra PCMC** was evolved. He/she is committed not only to provide help during golden hour but also train and educate citizens on emergency medical health practices. This can be achieved by arranging expert speaker and demo sessions from emergency response services.

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### Sector of Focus (Theme):

Arogya Mitra Sankalpana Training & Development under Smart City.

#### 4. Problem Statement:

The ignorance of individuals while attending a victim during emergency.

Most of us are unaware of the kind of medical attention or first aid to be given to an individual during the golden hour. There is a strong probability that in the event of any unforeseen medical emergency, we as individuals are unaware of the kind of first aid to be given.

Arranging and managing emergency help for an individual seeking help.

Besides giving first aid the arrangement and management of ambulance to transport the patient from location to nearest hospital is also observed to be one of the bottleneck.

### 5. Solution to the define problem:

- Arogya Mitra will undergo certified training for hands on emergency medical services
- Arogya Mitrawill realize importance of person, victim and situational control.
- Self-control and Situational Control and how to take patient from Accident Place to nearby Hospital.
- Understood First Aid and How to give First Aid Service.

Development of the Mobile App to increase the reach of Arogya Mitra to the Masses. The mobile app will be user friendly and help connect patient from location to hospital. It will have an emergency alarm that will immediately intimate the nearby hospital and Arogya Mitra volunteer. This will help ease of communication and required help.

Arogya Mitra is a unique concept redefining a Smart City. It is in it's nascent stage and while it grows it will have an IP component. 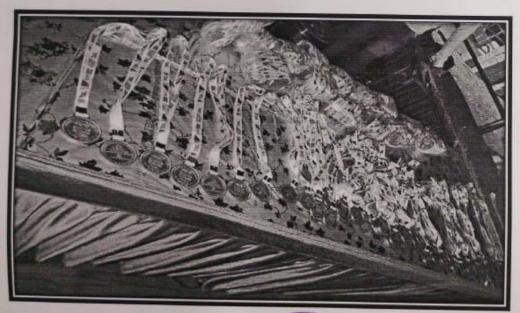

- 2. Date & venue: August 2019 at IICMR, Nigadi Campus.

#### 3. Outcomes of activity:

Students understand the seriousness of the situation & they also understand their roles in responding this critical situation. This drive unites the students for noble cause.

#### 4. Description of activity:

Floods are the major disaster affecting many countries in the world year after year. Flash flood was one of the most common and destructive weather related phenomena. It causes damage to lives, natural resources and environment as well as the loss of economy and health. Every year, the floods leave a trail of destruction, washing away villages, submerging paddy fields, drowning livestock, besides causing loss of human life and property in billions.

The spectre of floods hovers once more over Kolhapur and Sangli districts in western Maharashtra following incessant rain in the catchment areas throughout last week. This has resulted in a massive discharge of water from major dams, spiking the water level in the Panchganga river, which courses through Kolhapur, and the Krishna river that passes through Sangli. Residents living in the vicinity of these rivers in the two districts have been asked to move to safer zones by the district administrations.

On Monday, Koyna dam (in neighbouring Satara district) was almost filled to the brim with its present water stock at 103.08 thousand million cubic feet (tmcft), while Warna dam in Kolhapur is filled to capacity having a water stock of 34.05 tmcft.

Despite showers considerably reducing in intensity on Monday, the discharge was still on from all major dams, including Koyna (45,681 cusecs till Monday evening), Radhanagari (4,256 cusecs), and Warna (13,368 cusecs).

But an ongoing discharge of 2.5 lakh cusecs from Almatti dam in north Karnataka (adjoining Kolhapur) has done much to stave off fears of flooding in Sangli and Kolhapur for the moment. But the authorities not taken any chances with both districts yet to fully recover from a deluge which cost at least 35 human lives and killed hundreds of livestock besides damaging property and ruining crops to the tune of crores of rupees. Four National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) teams from Pune are on standby in both these districts, with two deployed in Kolhapur (one each in Shirol and Jaysinghpur tehsils) and the other two in Sangli (one each in Islampur and Miraj taluks). Even then, more than 750 persons from 350-odd families and hundreds of livestock, mainly in Shirol and Karvir tehsils, were relocated to safer areas on Sunday, while another 20-odd families in Sangli district were moved on Monday, according to Kolhapur and Sangli district administrations.

To help the victims in the Kolhapur & Sangali area the MBA@IICMR Institute taken the initiative to provide in terms of kind & money.

### 5. Activity Experience:

- a. The Management, Director sir, all staff members & students contributed in terms of kind & money.
- b. Collected materials has been dispatched to the needy with the help of the NGO association.
- c. The amount collected during the period has been deposited in the Chief Minister Relief Fund.

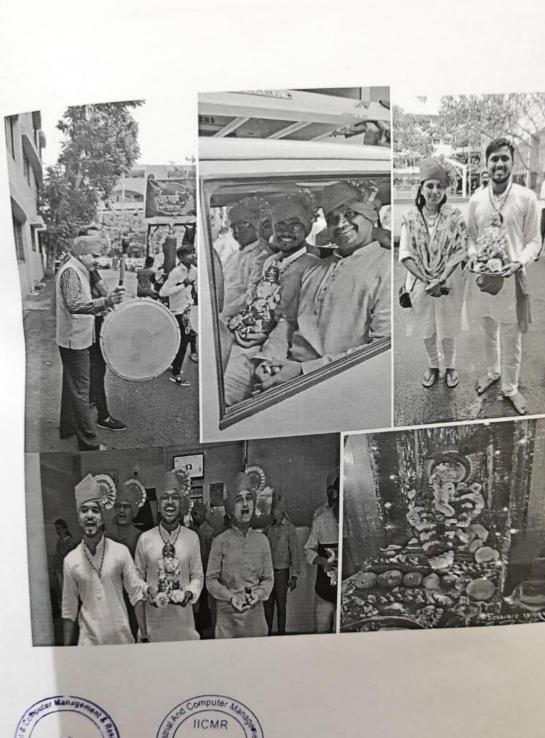
#### Feedback and Key Learning's:

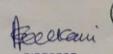

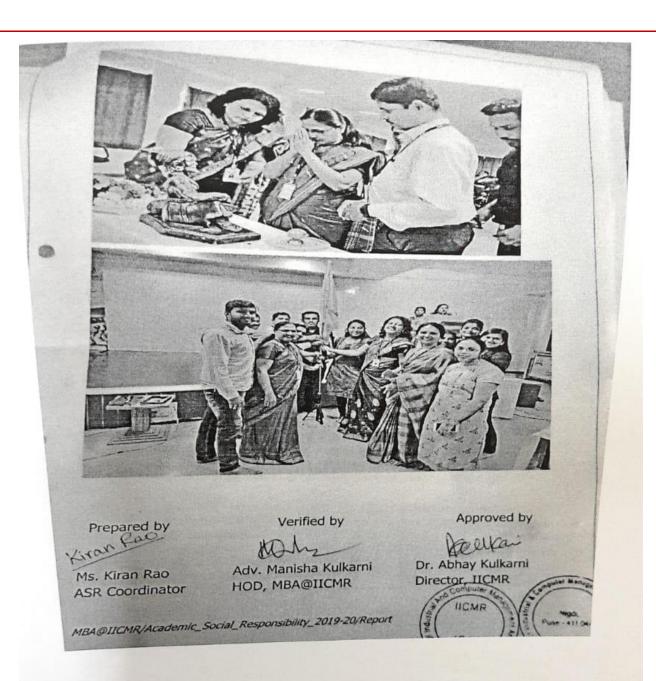

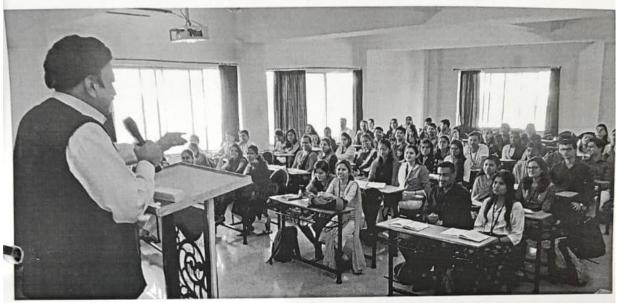
