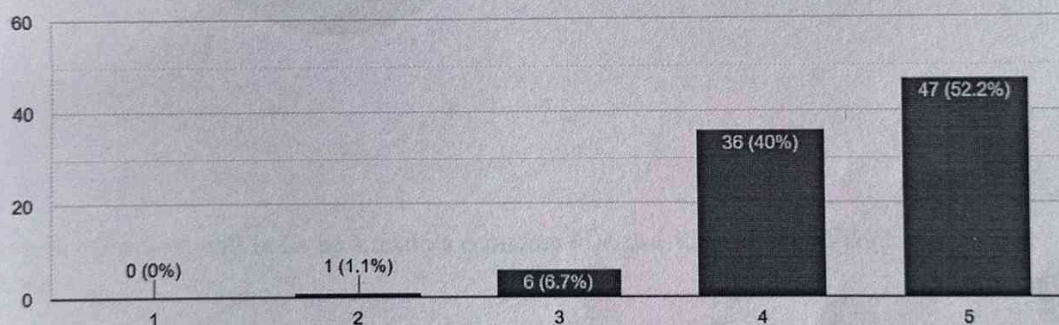

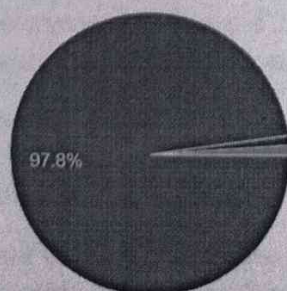
Feedback from the students:

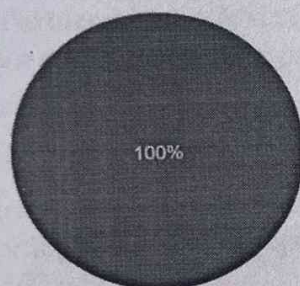

These insights collectively emphasize the pivotal role of education, collaboration, sustainability, and innovation in realizing the vision of Viksit Bharat for India's development by 2047.

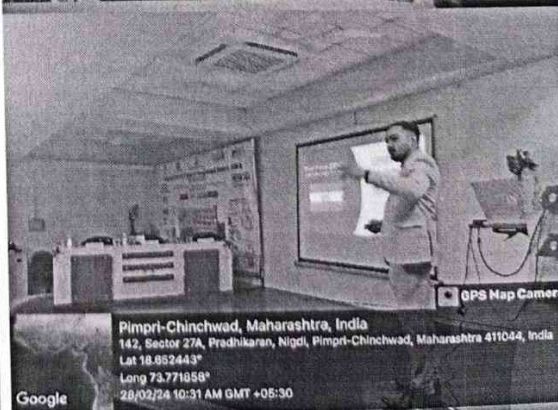
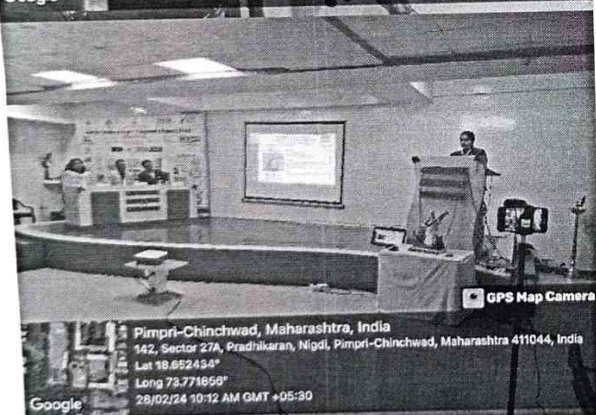
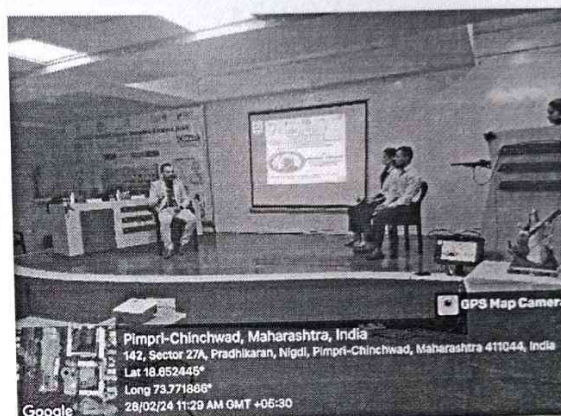
