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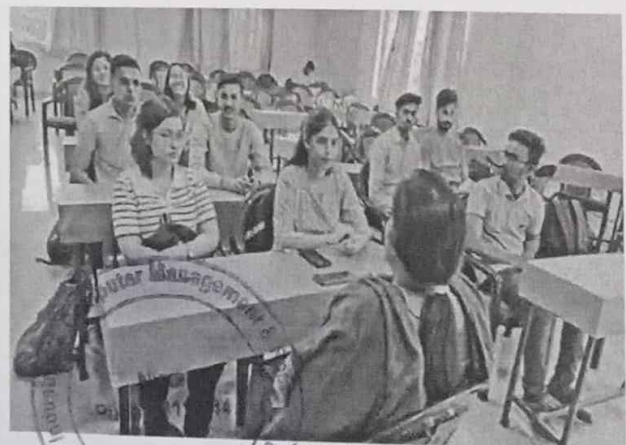
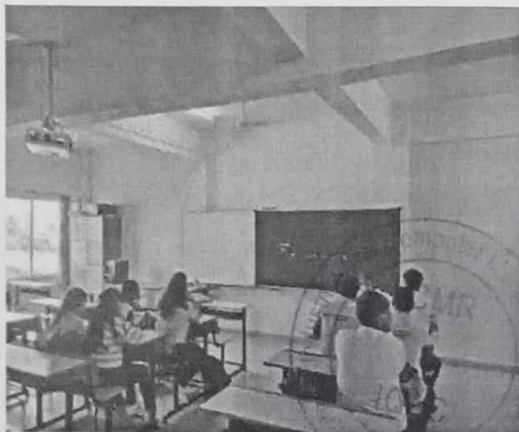
Mentors highlighted the importance of these sessions in fostering professional growth and preparing for future challenges in their respective fields.

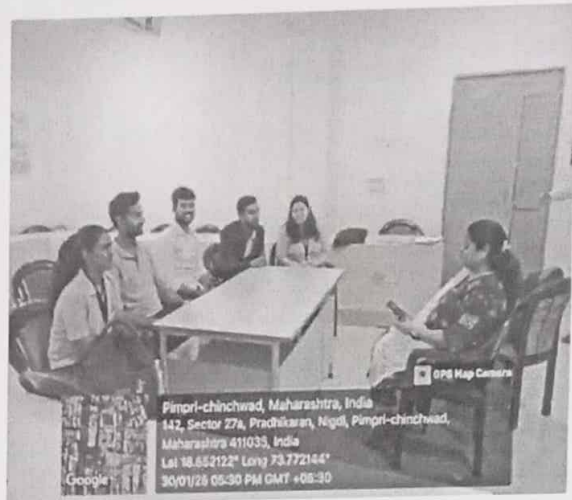
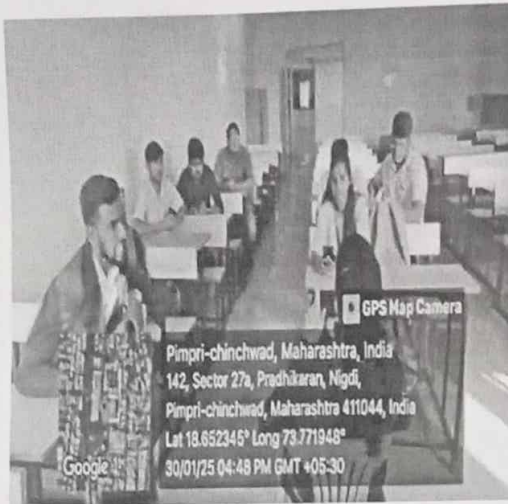






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
